Fraud/Scam	2019-11-08	Resident called to report a scam in which they received a call from a person claiming to be with Apple Care and demanding they purchase gift cards to fix a problem with their computer service. Resident reported a loss of \$500.
Theft Report	2019-11-12	Resident called to report a package that was supposed to be delivered yesterday never showed up. Resident suspects it was stolen.
Theft	2019-11-13	Officer contacted by staff that a resident of Deephaven Woods called to report approximately \$90.00 was taken from her wallet in her room. Officer gathered information from the victim and the staff. Staff member said there are no cameras in the common hallways, but they are looking into getting them.
Burglary - 1st Degree	2019-11-15	Officer was dispatched to an interrupted burglary on Leroy Street. Officer collected information and issued a KOPS alert on the suspect vehicle. Vehicle was later located, unoccupied. The vehicle had been reported stolen. No suspects located. Two power drills and some other hand tools were taken.
Burglary - Warrant Arrest	2019-11-16	An officer was dispatched to a suspicious vehicle that kept driving around a neighborhood in Deephaven with loud exhaust. A vehicle was located with loud exhaust and stopped. Three occupants of the vehicle were later detained and found to be acting suspicious. The driver was arrested for a warrant. Minnetonka Officers assisted and found a broken window on a business in Deephaven. Several tools, personal handheld two way radios and other items were seized from the vehicle for evidence, two occupants were allowed to leave and the driver was transported to jail on warrants and possession of narcotics. No items missing from the business that was entered.
Property Damage - Attempted Burglary	2019-11-17	Employees at business reported signs of attempted forced entry to the back door. Likely related to nearby burglary overnight. Interior doors were secured when employees entered and nothing was out of place or missing. Photos of damage attached in media section.
Property Damage	2019-11-20	Officer was dispatched to a property damage report. Officer arrived on scene and observed a broken rear window and another window that had damage on it. Officer observed the damage to be from what appeared to be a BB gun being shot at the vehicle.
Property Damage	2019-11-20	Officer dispatched to a property damage report. Officer arrived on scene and met with reporting party who stated she was sitting in her living room last night when she heard a loud noise. Reporting Party stated upon investigating it today she located a broken window and a pellet lodged in the window.
Property	2019-11-	Officer dispatched to a report of property damage for a broken

Damage	20	window on a truck. Officer arrived on scene and spoke with the reporting party who stated he found his truck window shot out. Officer advised of the problem in the area and documented the incident.
Traffic Stop - 3rd Degree DWI - Arrest	2019-11- 23	Officer stopped a vehicle for an illegal turn violation and the driver showed signs of alcohol impairment. Further investigation led to a DWI arrest of Jason Earl Kastner, 41 of Cambridge. The driver agreed to a breath test with a reported value of .19 AC. The driver was booked at the Hennepin County Jail for 3rd Degree DWI and Careless Driving.
Property Damage	2019-11- 24	Officer received an email regarding property damage at Thorpe Park's warming house. Officer arrived on scene and observed damage to the windows at Thorpe Park. Officer believes this damage was caused on the same night that several cars and a house were shot at by a BB or pellet gun. Officer documented the damage and uploaded it to this case under the media section.
