Identity Theft	2020-11-02	Victim reported unknown person applied for unemployment benefits in the State of Illinois using her identity.
Damage to Property	2020-11-02	An officer found a semi on a narrow street and observed it had hit a mailbox. Officer assisted the driver with where to go to pick up an excavator. The driver and officer left information for the homeowner and the mailbox was placed on their front step.
Traffic Stop - 4th Degree DWI - Arrest	2020-11-08	Officer was providing emergency lights for SLMPD Officer when a vehicle failed to move over. Officer initiated a traffic stop on the vehicle and observed clues of impairment. Officer asked the driver to step out and perform SFST's the driver, Thomas Rayar, 61 of Golden Valley failed SFST's and was arrested for DWI. Driver blew a .10 ac. Booked and released.
Traffic Stop - Citation	2020-11-15	Citation - Paraphernalia
Traffic Stop - 2nd Degree DWI	2020-11-18	Officer stopped a vehicle for speed. Officer observed the vehicle make a wide turn outside of its lane and failed to stop when officer activated their emergency lights for 2 blocks. Officer noted an odor of consumed alcohol and bloodshot watery eyes on the driver. The driver refused to perform SFSTs or provide a PBT sample. Officer arrested the driver, Lee Melvin McGillivray, 54 of Andover for DWI. The driver submitted a breath test which resulted in a .21 BAC. Driver was booked into Hennepin County Jail on 2nd Degree DWI. Vehicle is being held for forfeiture.
Theft from Auto - Phone Call	2020-11-19	RP called to report his car had been tampered with the day before. RP was making phone calls to credit card companies and advised he would provide a list when he was done. Officer phoned the RP the next day and was told the RP suffered no loss, all cards had been canceled in time. RP asked about the best way to spread the word to neighbors. Officer advised posting on all social media to lock doors.
Traffic Stop - Citation - Drug Paraphernalia	2020-11-23	Officer conducted a traffic stop for an equipment violation. Officer smelled an odor of marijuana emanating from the vehicle. Officer located drug paraphernalia within the vehicle.
Identity Theft	2020-11-24	An officer was dispatched to an identity theft call regarding business and personal accounts with an unknown suspect.
