| Harassment Complaint | 2021-11-01 | An officer spoke with a woman who stated she was being harassed by a male via Facebook Messenger. The victim wanted officers to contact the male and inform him she did not wish to be contacted anymore. Victim informed officer she had spoken to an attorney and was looking into getting a harassment restraining order. Victim also informed officer she knew of other females who had been a target of the male before and would pass my information along if they wanted to also make a report. Officer spoke to suspect who stated he was also feeling harassed by the victim. I informed the suspect he would need to report that to the South Lake Minnetonka police department. |
| Motor Vehicle Tampering | 2021-11-16 | Officer responded to a tamper with motor vehicle. Suspect was found looking inside victim's truck and took off. No loss. |
| Theft from Auto - Stolen Firearm | 2021-11-16 | A resident called to report their vehicles in the driveway had been gone through and someone stole a loaded handgun out of one of the vehicles. |
| Motor Vehicle Tampering | 2021-11-16 | A resident called to report both vehicles in their driveway had been gone through, officer responded and took a report and confirmed nothing was taken. |
| Theft from Motor Vehicle | 2021-11-16 | Officer took a theft from unlocked vehicle report. A purse was taken. |
| Motor Vehicle Tampering | 2021-11-16 | While investigating several motor vehicles tampering and theft from motor vehicle calls an officer was pointed to a residence that had video of a tampering on 10-28-2021. The officer responded and spoke to the homeowner and they later emailed a copy of the video to the officer. No Loss. |
| Theft from Motor Vehicle | 2021-11-16 | An officer found a post on Nextdoor for a resident who had items taken from their vehicle in their driveway, the officer responded and spoke to the resident and learned twenty dollars was taken. |
| Vehicle Theft | 2021-11-17 | Officers were dispatched to a motor vehicle theft. Suspects were no longer on scene and Officers spoke with the victim who said the vehicle was left running in the driveway when the theft occurred. The vehicle had a handgun left inside. Vehicle was located in St. Paul several days after the theft. |
| Tamper with Motor Vehicle | 2021-11-18 | Officer advised to call the RP because he wanted to report his vehicle had been gone through. RP said there was nothing of value in the vehicle and he thought he had locked it before going into the house. No loss. |
| Property Damage | 2021-11-19 | RP called to report a bus driver for his company had slightly bent the street sign at Linwood Rd and Cottagewood |
