Burglary	2019-10-02	Officer was dispatched to a burglary at a residence in Deephaven. Officers from DPD and Minnetonka PD cleared the house; finding no one inside. Crime Lab was summoned to process the scene. Case is under investigation.
2nd Degree DWI - Refusal (x2)	2019-10-06	A vehicle was stopped at State Highway 7 and Vine Hill Road after officer observed it had no headlights or taillights on. Upon stopping the vehicle, and when the officer was approaching, the driver and passenger switched positions. Both the driver and passenger had strong odor of alcoholic beverage on breath. Both occupants were arrested for DWI. The occupants were, James Allen Randolph Jr., 47 of Burnsville and Tia Tanisha Williams, 39 of Minneapolis. Both occupants refused to submit to chemical testing. Both were charged with 2nd Degree DWI and booked into Hennepin County jail. The vehicle was Forfeited.
Stolen Vehicle - Recovered	2019-10-22	Resident called to report his Mother's vehicle was stolen overnight by a friend who stayed the night. The vehicle was recovered in Minneapolis. The suspect will be charged with Theft of a Motor Vehicle.
Fleeing in M/V - Arrest	2019-10-25	Officer stopped a vehicle for failing to yield. As officer approached the vehicle, the driver fled. A pursuit ensued, and the vehicle was located unoccupied in the city of Minnetonka. An extensive search by multiple agencies proved successful, and the driver was found and placed under arrest. The driver was transported to Hennepin County Jail for fleeing in a motor vehicle and two outstanding misdemeanor warrants. The vehicle was towed to DPD. Suspect was charged for Fleeing in a Motor Vehicle and is currently being held at the Hennepin County Jail.
Traffic Stop - DWI - Arrest	2019-10-27	Officer stopped a vehicle for multiple moving violations. Driver produced clues of impairment and was put through SFST's. Driver refused to do the walk and turn, and the one leg stand exercises. Driver also admitted to consuming alcohol and being under the influence. The driver, Bruce Lee Stoppler, 32 of Minneapolis was placed under arrest for DWI. Driver agreed to a breath test which resulted in a .22 BAC reported value. Driver was booked into Hennepin County Jail for 3rd Degree DWI.
Domestic Abuse No Contact Order- Violation	2019-10-28	An officer suspected a subject of a domestic abuse no contact order may be in a home with a protected party. The officer later observed the party and spoke to the protected party who was leaving for the airport and said the individual is staying at the home while they are gone. While speaking with the protected party the occupants of the home turned off all the lights and closed all the curtains. It was confirmed that the

		subject was in the home. The subject will be charged via Formal Complaint for violating the No Contact Order of the Court.
