INCIDENT	INCIDENT DATE	INCIDENT DETAILS
Burglary / Vehicle Theft	2021-10-07	RP reported leaving his garage door open overnight and finding his BMW gone from inside garage. Suspects entered occupied home and took vehicle keys. Suspects used the stolen credit cards all over the metro and used the stolen vehicle for several days. Vehicle was recovered in Minneapolis- Suspects were later caught in Shorewood stealing another vehicle and after a highspeed pursuit, they were apprehended.
Traffic Stop - DAC-IPS / Narcotics - Arrest	2021-10-09	Officer stopped a vehicle for an inoperable headlamp. Investigation led to the arrest of the driver for DAC-IPS and possession of a controlled substance. Suspect was booked into Hennepin County Jail.
Traffic Stop - 2nd Degree DWI - Arrest	2021-10-09	Officer stopped a vehicle after observing multiple moving violations. The driver exhibited clues of impairment and was unable to satisfactorily complete SFST's; refusing to provide a PBT sample. The driver, <b>David Randall Plumb, 54 of Chaska</b> was placed under arrest and transported to DPD where he refused to take a breath test. The driver was ultimately transported to Hennepin County Jail.
Traffic Stop - Citation - Drugs	2021-10-11	Officers conducted a traffic stop on a vehicle for license plate light out. Officers spoke with the driver and conducted a SFST's on the driver. Through investigation Officers determined that there were drugs and drug paraphernalia in the vehicle. Officers located 4 grams of marijuana, a marijuana bong, and a marijuana grinder in the vehicle. Officers cited the driver for possession of marijuana and drug paraphernalia. Officers brought the evidence back to the PD, took photos, entered into evidence and attached documents to this case.
Traffic Stop - 4th Degree DWI / 5th Degree Possession	2021-10-11	Officer stopped a vehicle after observing an equipment violation. The driver was unable to provide a valid driver's license and provided admission of alcoholic beverage intake. The driver was unable to satisfactorily complete SFST's and provided a PBT sample. The driver, <b>Mark Allen Roepke, 41 of Hutchinson</b> was placed under arrest. During the search Methamphetamine was located on the driver's person. The driver transported to DPD where a search warrant blood test was requested. A blood test was conducted on the driver. The driver was ultimately transported to Hennepin County Jail.
Traffic Stop - 4th Degree DWI - Arrest	2021-10-17	Officer stopped a vehicle for speeding (65/55). The driver provided admission of alcoholic beverage intake. The driver was unable to satisfactorily complete SFST's and provided a PBT sample. The driver, <b>Patricia Ann Meuwissen, 58 of</b>

			<b>St. Bonifacious</b> was placed under arrest. The driver submitted to a breath test with a result of .12 ac. The driver was released to a family member who was deemed a responsible party.
Illegal Dumping	2021-10-21		An officer located a large pile of brush illegally dumped on the roadway, public works was notified.
Property Damage - Civil Issue	2021-10-22		Officer was dispatched to a report of juveniles smashing pumpkin's resulting in a broken window at a residence. Officer collected information and made contact with the juveniles involved.
Hit and Run- Damage to Property	2021-10-23		Officer dispatched to damage to a city lamp post and stop sign. A lineman for Xcel Energy called to report he came upon the lamp post. He cut the power to the post and temporarily secured the stop sign until the post could be replaced.
