INCIDENT	INCIDENT DATE	INCIDENT DETAILS:
Ordinance Violation - Unregistered Vehicle	2019-09-02	An officer observed a resident who was previously cited for unregistered stored vehicle had moved garbage cans in front of the vehicle blocking the license plate. The registration is still expired and the resident failed to appear or pay the fine for the citation last year, the registration is still expired as of May 2018. Another citation was issued and mailed to the residence.
Underage/Minor Consume Alcohol - Drug Possession	2019-09-06	Officers located a group of young adults and juveniles in Thorpe Park after hours. Further investigation lead to citations being issued for underage consumption of alcohol and possession of drug paraphernalia.
4th Degree DWI / Possess Drugs	2019-09-09	Vehicle was stopped for an equipment violation. The driver failed FST's and was arrested. The driver, Lacey Raye Brown, 26 of Hutchinson, blew a .09 ac. The driver was also charged with 5th degree Possession of a controlled substance. Driver was booked at the Deephaven PD and later released to a family member.
Traffic Stop - DWI - Arrest	2019-09-11	Officer stopped the listed vehicle for multiple moving violations. Officer noted and odor of consumed alcohol emitting from the vehicle. Officer then had the driver perform SFST's which provided additional clues of impairment. The driver, Alicia Faye Schimke, 43 of Chanhassen was placed under arrest for DWI. Driver was transported to the DPD where she was booked and released for 4th Degree DWI - Final reported value was .05 BAC.
Traffic Stop - 3rd Degree DWI - Arrest	2019-09-12	Officer conducted a traffic stop for a moving violation. Officer made contact with the driver and observed clues of impairment. Officer instructed the driver to do FST's and placed Marjorie Ellen Hellweg, 68 of Minnetonka under arrest for DWI. An evidentiary DMT test showed the driver had a BAC of 0.16 and was charged for 3rd degree DWI. Driver was booked into HC Jail.
4th Degree DWI	2019-09-15	Vehicle was stopped for a moving violation. The driver failed FST's and was placed under arrest. The driver, Nathan Angelo Pooley, 36 of Minnetonka tested a .09 AC. Driver was charged via Formal Complaint and released.
Phone Call - Theft Report	2019-09-18	Officer was dispatched to a phone call for a theft complaint. Officer spoke with the reporting party who stated that between 9/9/19 and 9/18/2019 a pair of "Miu Miu shoes" valued at \$750 were stolen from her mailbox. The USPS delivered the box to the mailbox.
Theft from Auto -	2019-09-22	A resident called to report credit cards were taken out of

CC Fraud		his vehicle, unknown when, but believed recently. The victim discovered the theft after receiving a fraud notice from three different credit card companies. Resident wanted a report filed for the credit card companies and wasn't interested in providing further information for us to investigate due to the credit card company taking care of it.
Cancel IPS - Arrest	2019-09-23	Officer responded to a suspicious activity call for a vehicle parked in a cul-de-sac running with lights on. Driver was ultimately arrested for having a cancelled IPS driving status. Driver was taken to Hennepin County Jail.
Property Damage	2019-09-27	Officer responded to Minnetonka Bl. and Highland Ave. for damage to property. The caller reported his surf board on his vehicle roof rack caught a low hanging cable wire that was across the road. The surf board sustained significant damage. Officer collected information and took photographs of the damage. The cable line broke and was moved to the side of the road.
Minor Consumption of Alcohol - Citation	2019-09-28	While on a medical at the listed location, Officer found one juvenile male carrying empty cans of beer down the driveway. Officer administered a PBT with a reading of .132 BAC. The juvenile male was cited for Underage consumption of alcohol and released.
