Property Damage	2020-09-01	A resident called to report that someone hit their mailbox during the night. Officer observed and photographed the mailbox which had been hit and ripped out of the ground.
Theft	2020-09-01	An officer observed early in the morning that a residence that has had recent problems with theft of political signs had signs missing as well as a sign replaced that had been painted with Black Lives Matters, ACAB and Gay rights painted on it. The resident later called to report the theft and provided a video from earlier in the morning that showed what looked like two young females placing the sign and taking a picture of it. The signs were taken around 2153 hours and the BLM sign was placed around 0129 hours.
Theft Report - Phone Call	2020-09-02	Officer phoned the RP regarding the theft of a Trump sign. Officer took the information and answered the RP's questions regarding preventing further theft of signs.
Traffic Stop - DWI Narcotics - Arrest	2020-09-03	Officer stopped a vehicle for speeding and multiple moving violations. The driver exhibited clues of impairment and was unable to satisfactorily complete SFST's. The driver, Jack Timothy Teal, 26 of Chanhasen was arrested for DWI and was also in possession of a controlled substance. A warrant was drafted and signed for a legal blood draw. The driver was ultimately transported to Hennepin County Jail and booked, Blood test results are pending.
Damage To Property	2020-09-05	Officer was dispatched to a suspected DWI at Carson's bay boat launch. Dispatch informed Officers that an individual hit a pole and jack knifed his trailer at the launch, in addition dispatch informed the reporting party stated that he smelled alcohol on the driver. Officers arrived on scene and made contact with the individual. Officers ran the individual through standardized field sobriety tests and the individual passed them all. Officer asked the individual how he hit the pole and he stated that he doesn't usually back trailers up and was having difficult problems. Photos of the damage was taken and uploaded to this case.
Damage To Property	2020-09-08	Officer received a phone call regarding a black lives matter sign that got "mangled". Reporting party stated he didn't know who did it, but wanted the Deephaven Police Department to be aware.
Theft of Services	2020-09-08	Officer was dispatched to a no pay at Primp Hair Salon. Officer spoke with the salon who stated that a female got a haircut and color valued at \$205. The salon stated that when the stylist walked the female up to the desk to pay the female asked to go to the bathroom and never came back. Officer was able to speak to the female suspect who stated that she believed she got a free voucher from the owner over a year ago. Officer advised the female suspect that she needed to

		contact the salon because they were unaware of this voucher. Incident was settled between both parties.
Theft Report - Phone Call	2020-09-09	RP called to report their Trump and We support our Police signs taken from their yard. Officer gathered information and advised her to continue reporting the thefts.
Theft Report - Phone Call	2020-09-12	Officer dispatched a scam report phone call. Officer called the Victim and learned \$5,000.00 was sent overnight to a Florida address. Officer gathered information and investigated the incident with the information provided.
Curfew Violation - Citation	2020-09-13	Officer happened upon two juveniles walking along the side of the road at the listed location. Contact was made with parents and the juveniles were transported home. Both were issued and explained citations before being released.
Traffic Stop - Narcotics - Arrest	2020-09-18	Officer stopped the listed vehicle for speeding. Officer detected an odor of marijuana coming from the vehicle. A PC search yielded alcohol, narcotics and paraphernalia along with possession of a controlled substance. An adult male was subsequently arrested and booked into Hennepin County Jail.
Harassment	2020-09-22	A resident and Deephaven Business owner called to report threats from a past client who sent the owners personal information to a disgruntled past employee after a disagreement over a job that was completed several years prior.
Fraud	2020-09-22	Officer dispatched to a phone call regarding an attempted identity fraud. Reporting party stated that she was alerted to someone trying to open an account with her social security number but was able to cancel it.
Theft Report	2020-09-24	RP called to report her paddleboard was taken from the rack at St Louis Bay. Officer gathered the information and provided the RP this case number.
Traffic Stop - DWI - Arrest	2020-09-24	Officer stopped a vehicle for speeding and lane use violations. The driver exhibited clues of impairment and was unable to satisfactorily complete SFST's. The driver, John Paul Lorence, 38 of Chanhassen was placed under arrest for DWI. Driver had a PBT result of .172. Driver later refused the breath test and was booked into Hennepin County Jail.
Curfew Violation - Citation	2020-09-26	While on routine patrol, officer located an occupied vehicle in the MCEC parking lot. Two juvenile occupants were in the back seat of the vehicle. Contact was made with their parents and both were released with citations for violating curfew.
Damage to Property	2020-09-27	CSO dispatched to Thorpe Park Restrooms for a utility check on a broken pipe. Upon further investigation CSO notice that the toilet had been damaged by a firework that had been dropped into it. Public works was notified and shut off the water to the bathrooms. RP stated she did not see anyone in

		the restrooms or around them when she noticed the issue.
