4th Degree DWI - Arrest	2021-09-03	SLMPD Officer happened upon a driver slumped over the steering wheel and blocking traffic. SLMPD requested DPD to respond and continue the investigation. Officer arrived and observed clues of impairment from the driver. The driver was unable to satisfactorily complete SFST's yielding a PBT sample of .159 AC. The driver, Gail Susan Smogard, 68 of Shorewood was placed under arrest for DWI and later agreed to take the breath test, yielding a final reported value of .15 BrAC. The driver was released from the DPD and transported home by the CSO.
Traffic Stop - Citation - Drugs	2021-09-04	Officer conducted a traffic stop on a vehicle for driving without lights on. As Officer was speaking with driver Officer smelled a strong odor of burned marijuana emanating from the vehicle. Officer questioned the driver of the vehicle about the marijuana and was handed a baggie containing 10 grams of marijuana. Driver conducted SFST's and mother was contacted via phone. Driver was cited for possession of marijuana in a motor vehicle and was allowed to park in a public parking lot and had parent come pick them up.
