INCIDENT	INCIDENT DATE	INCIDENT DETAILS:
Burglary	2023-06-02	Officer responded to the area of Sibley for 3 males who had gone into a garage and were going through vehicles. Unable to locate suspects.
Suspicious Activity	2023-06-02	Caller wanted to report that his house guest's car had been rummaged through. Nothing was missing.
Suspicious Activity	2023-06-02	Officer returned a call and was informed that a resident of Woodland had their unlocked vehicle gone through while they were out. Some cash was stolen.
DANCO Violation	2023-06-03	An officer received an email about a possible violation of a court order in an ongoing domestic abuse case. Case sent to the City Attorney.
Stolen Vehicle	2023-06-03	A resident of Florida called to report their Minnesota vehicle was stolen from a residence in Woodland where it was being stored with her key holder for her Plymouth residence. The vehicle was later recovered in St Paul by SPPD after BMW provided the GPS location for the vehicle. Case pending crime lab results and further leads as the suspects are unknown at this time.
Burglary - Theft from Vehicle - FTC Fraud	2023-06-03	A resident of Woodland called to report a past action burglary with theft from several vehicles and subsequent financial transaction card fraud.
Check Forgery	2023-06-16	A Deephaven business owner came to the police department to report check fraud on their business account.
Suspicious Activity - Citation- Drugs	2023-06-20	Officer located two males smoking marijuana on the side of Northome Ave. A citation was issued to one male for the marijuana and paraphernalia.
Damage to Property	2023-06-20	Homeowner is reporting a truck/trailer hit his retaining wall on June 19 before 1800 hours. The truck/trailer dislodged a large rock and damaged the irrigation system. Driver would have known he damaged the property. The trailer tire rubber was damaged and left behind pieces of rubber. Unknown truck and trailer left the area. Unknown damage cost.
