4th Degree DWI - 5th Degree Possession - Arrest	2023-05-22	2023-05-22	DH5C0	An officer received a phone call regarding a vehicle parked in a yard and a male sleeping inside. The officer contacted the male and determined he was under the influence of a controlled substance. The officer removed the male from the vehicle and placed him under arrest. Upon searching the male and vehicle multiple used needles were located and a needle with an unknown liquid substance was located. The liquid tested positive for meth and the male was transported to Hennepin Jail and charged with 5th degree drug possession and 4th degree DWI.
