The following statistics are Part 1 and Part 2 crimes reported for the month of August 2023:

INCIDENT	INCIDENT DATE	INCIDENT DETAILS:
Theft	2023-08-04	A resident called to report a snow roof rake and car cover missing from their property in the last month.
4th degree DWI - Arrest	2023-08-07	Driver was stopped for not having any taillights on after dark. The driver did not initially stop for my emergency lights and audible siren. The driver pulled into a gas station and parked. The driver had a strong odor of breath alcohol and poor balance. The driver conducted SFSTs and provided a PBT. The 67-year-old Excelsior man was arrested for DWI. Final breath result of .10. Driver was Cited and released.
Drug Arrest	2023-08-07	Officer was conducting patrol in the area of Deephaven main beach and located a vehicle backed into a parking spot with its headlights on and one occupant after hours. The officer approached the vehicle and located a male sitting in the driver's seat. The officer approached and spoke with the juvenile driver. The officer smelled the odor of marijuana coming from the vehicle and saw several marijuana rolling papers and vape pens in the juvenile's lap. The juvenile male admitted to having marijuana in the vehicle and advised the officer of its location. The marijuana was removed and placed in evidence. The juvenile's father was contacted and advised of the officers' findings then took custody of the juvenile. Juvenile was charged with Marijuana violations.
Phone Call - Internet Scam	2023-08-11	A resident of Deephaven fell victim to an internet scam and sent gift card codes over the phone to a unknown party.
4th Degree DWI - Arrest	2023-08-11	Driver was stopped for speed. Driver smelled of alcoholic beverage. Driver failed SFT's and was arrested. The female age 39 from Plymouth submitted a breath test with a result of .12. Driver was cited and released.
Theft from Vehicle - Stolen Handgun	2023-08-17	A resident of Winona who was staying at an address on Lakeview Avenue in Deephaven reported his truck was entered during the night and his Taurus handgun was taken.
Theft from Vehicle	2023-08-17	A resident of Deephaven called to report their vehicle had been entered sometime during the night, the only item taken was a small car battery jump pack.

Tamper with Motor Vehicle	2023-08-17	An officer was in the area of Cottagewood investigating several thefts from vehicles when they observed another vehicle that had been entered, the owner was advised and said nothing of value was missing.
Theft from Vehicle	2023-08-19	An officer discovered a vehicle that had been entered with items taken after a resident called to report they saw a bag on Minnetonka Boulevard, the officer contacted the homeowner who didn't believe anything of value was taken.
Stolen Vehicle - Recovered	2023-08-19	An officer found the contents from a glove box and a Mercedes rear view mirror in several spots on Rutledge Road, the owner of the vehicle was later contacted and confirmed with their daughter that the vehicle was stolen from an address on Rutledge where the daughter was staying at a friend's. The vehicle was later recovered in St Paul by the St Paul Police Department. Owner retrieved the vehicle.
Burglary - Theft from Vehicle	2023-08-20	A resident of Leroy Street called after finding the vehicle in their driveway had been entered, with the garage door opener taken and the garage entered. The resident advised she had checked the door at 2200 hours and it was secured, a neighbor reported seeing the garage open at 2300 hours. Both vehicles in the garage were entered. Only loss at this time is a garage door opener.
Burglary - Theft from Vehicle	2023-08-20	While in investigating a burglary and theft from motor vehicle, an officer was flagged down by two parties on Leroy Street who reported their truck in the driveway had been entered. The owner of the truck was going to look for gift card information that he believes were in the truck. The homeowner and guest also reported the front door was found ajar and it had been closed last night.
Traffic Stop – Marijuana Citation	2023-08-20	A vehicle was observed driving west on Northome Blvd and turned its lights off before turning onto Deephaven Ave. The vehicle did not have a visible rear or front license plate. The vehicle was stopped and found to have a temporary plate in the back tinted window. I approached the driver's side window and smelled a strong odor of marijuana coming from the vehicle. None of the occupants in the vehicle were 21 years old. The subject in the front passenger seat said there might be marijuana in the glove box. A bag of marijuana was found in the glove box in front of the subject. The subject admitted the marijuana was hers and she received a citation. All parents were notified and arrived to take custody of their children. The marijuana was collected, tested, and placed in evidence.
4th Degree DWI - Arrest	2023-08-21	While running stationary radar on Minnetonka Blvd near Northome Blvd I observed an east bound vehicle exceeding the posted speed limit. While at the open driver's window

		Officer smelled a strong odor of breath alcohol. I saw the driver had red watery eyes slurred speech. The driver performed SFSTs and refused a PBT. The driver, a 38-year-old from Elmhurst IL, was arrested. The driver provided a breath test of 0.09 BAC. The driver was issued a citation for 4th degree DWI and released.
Traffic Stop - Recovered Stolen	2023-08-25	Officer stopped a vehicle for crossing the center line. The vehicle was reported stolen from St. Paul. All occupants were juveniles and a parent were called to pick up the children. The case was sent to the County Attorney for charging. Vehicle was towed.
Tamper with Motor Vehicle	2023-08-25	A resident of Cottagewood called to report their neighbor told them that at 3am a vehicle pulled up and a party entered their vehicle. Calling to make the police aware, advised nothing was taken.
