INCIDENT	INCIDENT DATE	INCIDENT DETAILS:
AOA- Fleeing in M/V- Pursuit	2023-12-02	Officer responded to a burglary in progress in Shorewood. Officer met the vehicle on Blvd in Greenwood and was almost struck by driver. Officer initiated a stop and driver fled at high speeds. Officer tried stopping it until Officer lost visual on HWY 62. State Patrol and Minneapolis located the vehicle and it fled again. Subject stopped the car and four males ran from the vehicle. The vehicle was determined to be stolen out of Minneapolis. Four males were apprehended, with the help of State Patrol Helicopter. Three males were 13 years old and one was 17-year-old. All were charged via Hennepin County Attorney's Office.
Theft from Motor Vehicle	2023-12-02	Officer was dispatched to a theft from a motor vehicle. Officer spoke to the RP and learned that the owner was missing a gas credit card and a work ID. Unknown suspects.
Fraud	2023-12-04	An officer took a report for a resident reporting someone attempted to file for unemployment in his name. The resident stated he already reported it to the BBB and the unemployment officer who advised him to file a police report as well.
Damage to Property - Narcotics Complaint	2023-12-08	The Deephaven Public Works Supervisor reported damage to property to the Thorpe Warming house from a marijuana smoker who is frequently going to the warming house to smoke, the incident occurred between 0900-1000 hours after public works cleaned. Officer responded and took pictures and noticed the smell of burnt marijuana. This is an ongoing problem with multiple people reporting it, suspect drives a blue Range Rover or an off-white Mercedes Benz passenger car.
Traffic Stop- Formal Complaint	2023-12-08	Officer was on patrol and observed the listed vehicle going 45 mph in 35 mph zone. Officer conducted a traffic stop and observed that the vehicle had expired registration and was displaying registration that came back to a different vehicle. Charges will be sent to the city attorney. See report for further details.
Suspicious Activity-	2023-12-14	Officer found a vehicle parked at the Thorpe Park Warming House parking lot. Lights were on in one of the bathrooms

Damage to Property		and the bathroom smelt of burnt marijuana. No one was located. The vehicle was unlocked and keys left in the car. Officer took keys for safe keeping and locked vehicle. Minnetonka contacted the vehicle owner. The 18-year-old vehicles owners son admitted to smoking marijuana in the bathroom. Damage was done to the bathroom window sills. Working on restitution for damages.
Traffic Stop - Cancel IPS- Arrest	2023-12-29	Officer was on patrol and observed an know individual driving a black sedan. Officer conducted a driver's license check on the individual and observed his driver's license status was Cancelled - IPS. Officer conducted a traffic stop and arrested the driver. Driver taken to HC Jail.
Theft Report	2023-12-31	An officer was dispatched to a possible theft at listed residence. The RP told the officer the victim appears to have \$90 cash missing from his wallet. The RP did not know who could have taken the money. The RP was having the door code changed that day and begin to limit caretakers allowed in the residence. The RP also requested extra patrol in the area.
