INCIDENT	INCIDENT DATE	INCIDENT DETAILS:
Identity Theft	2023-10-03	An officer received a phone call regarding identify theft and a credit card opened in her name. The RP spoke to their bank as well as a lawyer and disputed the charges with the FTC. RP is in contact with her lawyer and will update PD on any changes.
Verbal Domestic - Arrest - Cancelled IPS	2023-10-06	An officer was dispatched to a residence for a verbal domestic with one party who left in a vehicle, party was located and arrested for driving canceled inimical to public safety. Subject was taken to Hennepin County Jail.
Dumping Complaint	2023-10-18	An officer was flagged down by a resident to report a fridge had been left at the bottom of their driveway with "BLM" "Hillary 2024" and "Get your shot now!". The officer had public works transport the fridge to the PD. The homeowners believed they knew who the fridge belonged to. Refrigerator owner was contacted and said it was a prank on his friends. He retrieved the refrigerator the following day.
Theft	2023-10-23	An officer received a phone call about a stolen wallet that was used at Best Buy in Minnetonka. US Bank flagged the purchase as fraud and the victim was able to cancel all her credit cards. No monetary loss, follow up at Best Buy confirmed they did not have video footage in the parking lot. No vehicle or suspect description was given. RP confirmed the cards were not used anywhere else.
Damage to Property	2023-10-27	Officer was dispatched to an egging. Officer was told the RP's house and car was egged. Officer advised the RP to keep records and to provide the PD with the receipts for cleanup and damage. Officer checked the area but did not locate anything.
Fraud/Scam	2023-10-28	A resident called to report that he had been scammed out of \$100 on Facebook marketplace.
