Fraud Report	2024-01-22	Officer received a call about an identity theft/ fraud that resulted in the loss of approximately \$130,000.00. The officer contacted the reporting party and gathered information about the theft. The reporting party stated he had already contacted his bank and the social security administration.
Burglary	2024-01-26	Officer was dispatched to a burglary report at the listed address. Officer investigated and eventually received assistance from an officer from Minnetonka PD. The RP was able to provide information, including identifying information, of the two female suspects, and a vague description of what was taken. All three of the involved parties were at one point in the listed residence. It was eventually determined that a theft/burglary did take place at the residence and the stolen items were dropped off at DPD by one of the suspects. The victims are interested in pursuing criminal charges. Investigation continues.
Vandalism	2024-01-28	Officer was dispatched to a report of someone's house being egged the night prior. Officer arrived, spoke to the homeowner, and took pictures. No damage yet. Homeowner stated he would advise.
