INCIDENT	INCIDENT DATE	INCIDENT DETAILS:
Phone Call - HRO - Welfare Check	2024-02-09	Officer was dispatched a phone call regarding a court order violation. The RP was calling to report on herself for violating an HRO. Officer attempted to speak with the RP for several minutes, who was very emotional and agitated, possibly intoxicated and/or in a mental health crisis. Officer requested the Orono Police Department check on the RP. Subject was charged via Formal Complaint for Violation of a Harassment Order.
Theft from Vehicle	2024-02-13	An officer took a lobby walk in report for a theft of tools from a vehicle parked at Robinsons Bay beach.
Domestic - Arrest	2024-02-19	Officer dispatched to a residence for a physical domestic. Officer arrived on scene and discovered that the juvenile assaulted two individuals at the residence. The juvenile was arrested and transported to Hennepin County Juvenile Detention Center.
Domestic - Arrest	2024-02-23	Officers were dispatched to a juvenile who had thrown a Stanley cup through a car windshield, the juvenile had charged at the father who called 911 after the parents told him he couldn't take his vehicle as a punishment for skipping school earlier in the day. The juvenile was evaluated on scene by Hennepin Healthcare and later arrested and brought to the Hennepin County Juvenile Detention Center for Domestic Assault and Damage to Property.
