INCIDENT	INCIDENT DATE	INCIDENT DETAILS:
Illegal Dumping - Verbal Warning	2024-04-11	An officer gave a verbal warning to a business owner who was doing work in Chimo West and dumped garbage into the Carson Bay Boat Launch dumpster.
School Bus Stop Arm Violation	2024-04-25	First Student sent a school bus stop arm violation to the police department that had occurred earlier in the morning at Minnetonka Boulevard and Fairhomes Lane. The driver was located and charged via formal complaint.
Warrant Arrest- Recovered Stolen Property	2024-04-28	Officer was notified by a resident that they possibly purchased a stolen UTV side by side.
