The following statistics are Part 1 and Part 2 crimes reported for the month of July 2024:

INCIDENT	DATE	DETAILS
Burglary	2024-07-05	RP reported several items missing from her attached garage over the last few weeks. The garage has been left open often while residents are home and away.
Theft	2024-07-09	An officer was dispatched to a report of a catalytic converter stolen from a vehicle. The officer took pictures and noted no residents in the area had cameras. The RP did not know when it was stolen but suspected in the last week. The RP stated their insurance would not cover the theft and they were planning on selling the car shortly. The RP stated they would call with any further information.
Disturbance - Citation - Underage Consumption	2024-07-20	Officer was called to a residence in regards to a disturbance. RP stated that an unknown male was knocking on the door at their residence. Officer made contact with the male, who was confused and intoxicated. Officer identified the male and discovered he was a minor. Officer transported the male to the Deephaven Police Department and was later picked up by his mother. A citation was issued for Underage Consumption of Alcohol.
Subject Stop - Citation - Underage Consumption	2024-07-20	Officer saw a suspicious female walking around Calvary Church. The female was talking on the phone holding a blue can. I approached the female as she moved the can behind her left leg. I asked her if she was holding a beer and she said she was and was only 20 years old. She submitted a PBT of 0.115 BAC. Female was issued a citation for Underage Consumption of Alcohol.
Damage to Property	2024-07-23	An officer was dispatched to a Vandalism report at Deephaven Main Beach parking lot. The officer observed black spray painting of vulgar sayings and images. Public works was notified to clean it up.
Runaway - Located	2024-07-26	Officer took a runaway report from the mother. The juvenile was later located in Chanhassen and arrested on a Carver County warrant.
Dumping Complaint	2024-07-27	An officer on routine patrol observed a pack and play, toddler rail and upholstery steamer dumped on the side of the road. The officer took the items and placed them in the police department dumpster.
