The following statistics are Part 1 and Part 2 crimes reported for the month of May 2024:

INCIDENT	INCIDENT DATE	INCIDENT DETAILS:
Domestic Assault - Arrest- Formal Complaint	2024-05-10	A party requested a civil standby at her elderly mothers' home when she was going to arrive to keep the peace with her sister, while on scene the party was trying to enter the home when the sister physically assaulted her, the sister was arrested and booked into the Hennepin County ADC.
Fatality Motor Vehicle Accident- Death Investigation	2024-05-13	Officers was dispatched to a vehicle accident at Excelsior Blvd. and Vine Hill Road. Driver #1 failed to stop at the stop sign on Excelsior Blvd. striking Vehicle #2 in passenger front and side. Vehicle #2 was pushed across the roadway over the curb into the grass right of way. Vehicle # 2 driver was taken by ambulance to HCMC. Driver of Vehicle #1 admitted his brakes were bad and he didn't see the sign until it was too late. Driver of Vehicle #1 was charged with multiple offenses. PD was notified 7 days later that the driver of Vehicle #1 had died due to her injuries. Case has been sent to County Attorney for charges.
Theft - Recovered	2024-05-13	Officer was dispatched to a theft. Officer was enroute to another call when officer located the bike off of Minnetonka Blvd. Checked area for suspect. Unable to locate anyone. Juvenile allegedly took bike. Officer called the reporting person and they recovered the bike.
Neighbor Complaint- Criminal Damage to Property	2024-05-14	Resident reported that her flowers and bushes had been damaged by someone spraying Roundup.
Unwanted Person - Warrant Arrest - Narcotics	2024-05-15	A resident of Deephaven called to report an unwanted party trying to enter their home saying they owned the home, officers responded and arrested the party after it was found they had an Anoka County arrest warrant for assault. The party was booked into jail for the warrant as well as charges for narcotics which were found in her pocket.
Permit Parking - Cannabis - Citation	2024-05-24	A community service officer came upon a vehicle parked in the permit parking lot at Walden Beach, upon contact the CSO smelled a strong odor of cannabis and contacted an officer. The officer contacted the vehicle driver and the driver handed over a sandwich bag with just under an ounce of cannabis, the driver was cited with improper packaging and released with a verbal warning for the permit parking.

	Ordinance Violations- Citations	2024-05-26	Subjects were found fishing from the city docks for a second time in the same night. Subjects were given a verbal warning previously and returned to continue fishing. The subjects were found to be in violation of curfew and was issued a citation for both offenses. Both subjects' parents were called and notified of the violations and citations.
