INCIDENT	DATE	INCIDENT DETAILS
Burglary	2024-09-13	Officer dispatched to a residence for a burglary report. A window was broken out of an attached garage and items taken from the two vehicles inside. HC Crime Lab responded for prints and photos.
Theft from Motor Vehicle	2024-09-13	A resident reported his unlocked vehicle parked in the driveway had been entered and the contents gone through overnight. A garage door remote was taken.
Tamper with Motor Vehicle	2024-09-13	A resident reported that his unlocked vehicle parked in their driveway had been gone through overnight with the contents of the glovebox strewn on the seats, nothing of value taken.
Theft from Motor Vehicle	2024-09-13	A resident called to report that their unlocked vehicle was gone through while parked in their driveway last night, they found the only thing missing was a \$50 bill. The resident shared security video from 2220 hours that shows their dog barking and a vehicle driving by.

	Damage to Property	2024-09-21	Officer dispatched to a home on Rutledge Rd. for damage to a vehicle. The vehicle had large dents in the hood and a cracked windshield. The damage occurred overnight. Photographs were taken. No known suspects.
	Pursuit - Arrest- Vehicle Forfeiture	2024-09-23	An officer learned Minnetonka PD was following a vehicle wanted in a Felony domestic assault in Plymouth. The officer located the vehicle along with Minnetonka PD and South Lake Minnetonka PD and initiated a stop. The vehicle fled to Excelsior and the driver was arrested for Fleeing in a Motor Vehicle. The vehicle was forfeited. Driver was booked on Felony Fleeing and Plymouth's charges.
	Damage to Property	2024-09-30	An officer was dispatched to a resident whose side vehicle window had been broken out. Looked to be someone trying to pry the door open. The officer took photos and gathered information for a report.
