Info: Possible Fraud	2025-01-16	The RP called to report that her father is sending money to a female in the UK via a Bitcoin ATM. The male is currently going through a divorce and will not listen to his family this is a scam. The RP is wanting the incident documented and provided screen shots of text conversations. The male party is unaware of the RP is making the report.
Mental Health – Hold- Assault on a Police Officer	2025-01-17	Officer dispatched to the listed residence, for an individual experiencing mental health issues. Officer arrived on scene and contacted the individual. A physical altercation ensued between the officer and subject, in which the subject punched the officer in the face. The subject was later detained and put on a mental health hold. Charged via Formal Complaint.
AOA - Traffic Complaint- Underage Drink and Drive- Possession of Alcohol by Minor	2025-01-19	Officer was called by HCSO Water Patrol about a driving complaint on Carson Bay. The officer learned a pickup truck was doing doughnuts on the ice near ice houses. The officer arrived in the area and saw a pickup drive into Carson Bay and start to do doughnuts. The officer advised the HCSO Water Patrol that the vehicle was back in the area. The officer saw the vehicle begin to drive off the lake and initiated a traffic stop along with HCSO Water Patrol. The officer approached the driver’s side open window to speak with the four occupants after HCSO Deputy spoke with the driver. While speaking with the occupants in the vehicle, the officer smelled to odor of a consumed alcoholic beverage coming from the vehicle. The driver admitted to having Twisted Tea in the vehicle. All four occupants were instructed to exit the vehicle. Three out of the four were found to have been drinking. I issued one passenger a citation for minor consumption and the driver for under age consumption while driving. All individuals’ parents were contacted. The three individuals who had been drinking were released to parents.

ACCIDENT	DATE	DETAILS
PD Accident	2025- 01-10	Officer was dispatched to a single vehicle property damage crash. Vehicle slid off the road on Heathcote.
PD Accident	2025- 01-16	Officer responded to a vehicle crash at the intersection of Highway 7 and Vine Hill Rd. The driver stated he was following the vehicle in front of him when the light turned yellow. The driver believed the vehicle in front of him was going to go through the light, but stopped. The driver was not able to stop in time and struck the vehicle in front of him causing moderate damage to both vehicles. Driver was cited.
PD Accident	2025- 01-18	Officer responded to the report of a parked vehicle that had been hit at Bay Street and Cottagewood Avenue. The officer arrived and took pictures and collected the owner's information. The driver who struck the parked vehicle did leave a note and was contacted to obtain photos and her information. A state crash report was completed.
PD Accident	2025- 01-22	An officer was flagged down for a property damage crash at Minnetonka Bl. and Vine Hill Rd. There was minor damage to a vehicle's mirror by a trailer. An accident exchange form was completed and given to both parties.
