DOCKS - TEN YEAR TERM LIMIT Located in both St. Louis Bay and Carson's Bay.	At least 16' up to 26' <u>including all equipment and attachments</u>	Up to 8' 6" in width.	Motorboats only. Sailboats, canoes and watercraft without motors are <u>not</u> permitted at City docks. Boat length of a watercraft at a dock slip means the horizontal measurement from the foremost to the aftermost points of the watercraft, including all equipment and attachments in their normal operating positions, shall not exceed twenty-six (26) feet and must be in compliance with all Lake Minnetonka Conservation District regulations pertaining to boat length as it pertains to Deephaven's municipal dock licenses. BUOYS - TEN YEAR TERM LIMIT Located in both St. Louis Bay and Carson's Bay.	16' to 25'	N / A	Sailboats and Powerboats. Sailboats must have their mast erected the entire boating season or will be considered non-operational which is not allowed per City code. NOTE: No access to buoy is provided by the City. Resident is allowed to have a canoe rack or slide along with a buoy.	CB - 25 SB - 28	53	\$625.00
SHORESPACE Located in St. Louis Bay only, just South of the Main Swim Beach.	16' to 34'	No wider than width of your assigned shorespace	Build and maintain own dock. Take dock in and out yourself. Cost varies depending on footage assigned, boats at least 16' and not more than 34' long. No wider than the width of the shorespace. No dock on a shorespace may exceed 40 feet in length. Only 15 shorespaces are rented, four are for City use only.	St. Louis Bay (4 are City use only)	19	\$145.00 per foot
CANOE RACKS Located in both St. Louis Bay and Carson's Bay.	Must be appropriate to canoe rack & not overlap into neighbors space.		Only for canoes, small boats such as rowing shells, sailboards used for windsurfing & the "sunfish" or "laser" boats, kayaks and paddleboards, so long as the watercraft does not exceed the width of the rack and does not interfere with the use of the rack for other permitted watercraft. Two watercraft are allowed on one rack IF they fit on rack without overlapping into neighbors space.	SB - 30 CB - 18	48	\$100.00
B2 SLIDES Located in both St. Louis Bay and Carson's Bay. Wooden pallets along the shoreline.	16 feet long from stem to stern (does not include motor)	Up to 5' 4" width. If a boat is over 5' 4" in width on a B2 slide, it must have a wide boat permit with approval from City Hall. Wide boat permits are not guaranteed in any space or for more than one boating season.	Must be able to pull boat up on shore. Fishing boats & small motorboats only. B2 Slide Pallets along the shoreline are 16' wide, three watercraft typically share each pallet. Boats on the slides cannot exceed 5 feet, 4 inches in width WITHOUT an annually approved wide boat permit from the City. No motors other than outboard motors. No boat may be kept at a slide unless it is a size and weight that permits the owner to pull the boat from the water manually. Jet skis / personal watercraft ARE allowed. Canoes, kayaks, rowing shells and other boats of similar design shall NOT be permitted on a slide— UNLESS they had been grandfathered in and provide annual letter from doctor stating they have medical reasons making it too difficult for them to carry and lift their canoe onto a canoe rack. B1 SLIDES Located in St. Louis Bay only.	Up to 17' 6" in length (Does not include motor)	5' 4" up to 7 feet wide (minimum width is 5' 4", boats under are not allowed on B1 slides.)	B1 slides are intended solely for boats in excess of 5' 4" wide. If the boat you place on your B1 slide is not wider than 5' 4" you are NOT ELIGIBLE for a B1 slide. You must be able to manually pull your boat onto the slide or install an approved winch system. B1 Slide pallets along the shoreline are 16' wide, two boats share each pallet. Boats on B1 slides cannot exceed 7' in width without an annually approved wide boat permit from the City.	SB - 20	20	\$450.00
STREET END SLIDES Located in the Cottagewood area.	16 feet long from stem to stern (does not include motor)	Up to 5' 4" width (same as B2 slides listed above).	Same restrictions for B2 slides apply to Street End Slides. Locations - Bay Street (3) and Water Street (3). Watercraft on Street End Slides cannot exceed 5' 4" in width WITHOUT an annually approved wide boat permit from the City.		6	\$325.00
