INCIDENT	DATE	INCIDENT DETAILS
Traffic Stop - Canceled IPS - Formal Complaint	2026- 04-07	Officer received a Flock ALPR hit for a Cancelled-IPS registered owner. The driver matched the registered owner and the vehicle was stopped. Officer confirmed the driver was the registered owner and his license was Cancelled-IPS. The driver was charged via Formal Complaint. Gross Misdemeanor DAC-IPS.
Ordinance Violation - Park After Hours - Curfew-Verbal Warning	2026- 04-11	Officer observed a vehicle parked in Thorpe Park running after hours. Officer spoke to the driver and passenger who were both juveniles. Both juveniles were given verbal warnings for park after hours and curfew and released.
DWI - Arrest	2026- 04-25	Officer stopped a vehicle for speed on Minnetonka Blvd. and Chimo East. Officer observed indicators of impairment and conducted standardized field sobriety tests on the driver. The driver provided a preliminary breath sample of 0.246 and was placed under arrest for DWI. The driver, a 32-year-old man from Victoria was transported to the Deephaven Police Department and agreed to take a breath test. The driver provided breath samples with a final BrAC of .25. The vehicle was impounded. South Lake Minnetonka PD Community Service Officer transported the male to Hennepin County Jail for Probable Cause 3rd Degree DWI.
