	Harassment	2026-02-01	Officer received a call from a prior assault victim who was being harassed by the suspect on Facebook. The victim had several posts made on her Facebook saying she should be assaulted, posted by the suspects Facebook account. Sent to City Attorney for review of charges.
	Theft - License Plate	2026-02-04	Officer received a phone call, in regards to a stolen license plate. Officer entered the license plate as stolen.
	Vandalism	2026-02-20	Officer took a phone call from a resident on Maple Hill Road who was concerned about juveniles threatening to vandalize his house later in the night. The reporting party requested extra patrols in the area overnight. Officer conducted directed patrols hourly and did not see anyone in the area. Officer was later called back to the residence after the residence was vandalized. Officer took photos and gathered information about who the homeowners believed vandalized the residence.
