The following statistics are Part 1 and Part 2 crimes reported for the month of June 2026:

INCIDENT	DATE	INCIDENT DETAILS
Traffic Stop- Underage Drink and Drive- Underage- Consumption Citations	2026-06-06	While parked at the intersection of Minnetonka Blvd and Maplewood Rd, I saw a southbound vehicle on Maplewood Rd sitting at the stop sign for a prolonged period of time. The vehicle made a U-Turn in the intersection and drove back northbound on Maplewood Rd. I followed the vehicle and saw that it was over the center line as it drove north. I initiated a traffic stop and smelled a strong odor of alcohol coming from the open driver's window. The driver denied drinking and I had him exit the vehicle. I continued to smell a moderate odor of breath alcohol on the driver as I spoke with him. I observed some signs of impairment on SFSTs. Driver provided a PBT with a result of 0.070 BAC. While conducting an inventory of the vehicle I located a fake Iowa driver's license with the driver's picture and name, but with a DOB that made him 22 years old. The other four occupants of the vehicle were taken out of the vehicle and PBT's were obtained. All four passengers were issued citations for minor consumption. All five occupants of the vehicle were picked up by parents, family members or an Uber.
Damage to Property	2026-06-14	CSO was down at Deephaven Main Beach when he was approached by a Resident that had damage done to their inflatable paddleboard. CSO documented the incident. Unknown damage amount.
Traffic Stop - Underage Consumption - Fictitious Licenses - Formal Complaint	2026-06-20	Officer conducted a traffic stop on a vehicle for driving through a closed road. Officer observed the vehicle had space for four passengers but contained eight passengers in the vehicle. The passengers were all under the age of 21 and had all consumed alcohol. The driver was not impaired. Officers from the Wayzata, Minnetonka, and South Lake Minnetonka Police Departments responded to assist. Seven of the passengers were not wearing seatbelts, and six of the passengers possessed fictitious drivers' licenses. Empty alcohol containers and an open half consumed container of alcohol were found in the trunk. All parties were released to responsible drivers. This case was forwarded to the City Attorney for various charges detailed in the supplemental report.

Accidents June 2026

ACCIDENT	DATE	DETAILS
PD Accident	2026-06-02	While on patrol the officer located a PD crash in the parking lot of the Deeptaven Main Beach. A female driver had backed into a car parked behind her as she tried to exit her parking spot. The officer took photos of both vehicles and obtained the driver's information and insurance. The owner of the second vehicle was located and his information was obtained. An accident exchange form was completed. The officer completed a state crash report.
PD Accident	2026-06-04	An officer and Community Service Officer were dispatched to a Hit and Run at James Ave and Deeptaven Ave. The officer and CSO took the registered owner's information and documented the damage done to her vehicle. It was determined that a landscaping company turned out of the street and the rear of the commercial trailer hit the vehicle. No damage to the landscaping company trailer and both parties were going to work out insurance information to get the vehicle fixed.
PD Accident - Careless Driving - Formal Complaint	2026-06-13	Minnetonka Police came upon an accident that had occurred on Vine Hill Road and driver had pulled into a parking lot near Minnetonka Community Education Center. Officer responded after dealing with a separate call. Officer learned the driver had struck a telephone pole on Vine Hill Road while driving northbound. Officers learned the driver had also been inhaling nitrous oxide after Officers found his vehicle parked. Officer did not observe any signs of impairment while on scene. The male stated he was not injured, did not need an ambulance, and did not want a tow truck called for his vehicle, which was parked in the lot legally. This case was sent to the city attorney for charges of Careless Driving.
PD Accident	2026-06-15	Officer was notified of a property damage crash on Northern Rd where a truck hit the mirror of another truck. A parking citation was written to a box truck for parking on the wrong side of the street.
PD Accident - Citation	2026-06-18	An officer and community service officer were dispatched to a property damage accident at the Coldwell Banker parking lot. The officer learned a vehicle failed to yield when turning onto Vine Hill Road from Excelsior Boulevard and struck a southbound vehicle on Vine Hill Road. An accident exchange form was given to both drivers and the driver who failed to yield was Cited.
PD Accident	2026-06-29	Officer was dispatched to a property damage accident at Highway 7 and Vine Hill Rd. Officer wrote a crash report and completed an information exchange form.

PD Accident - Hit and Run	2026-06-29	While on patrol the officer was flagged down by a female who wanted to report her parked car had been struck while it was parked on Jericho Road. The female showed the officer camera video from a nearby home that showed a white SUV backing up towards the parked car. The female said an Uber driver stopped and told her he witnessed the incident.
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
