	INCIDENT	DATE	DETAILS
	Identity Theft	2026-03-11	A resident of Deephaven called to report their social security number and family foundation were used to open a bank account. The family received collections notices in the mail and discovered the fraudulent transactions, they are working with the bank and should have no loss once reported as fraud with the bank.
	3rd Degree DWI	2026-03-11	Officer conducted a traffic stop on a vehicle after observing it fail to maintain its lane. Officer observed signs of impairment in the driver and performed standardized field sobriety tests on the driver. The driver submitted to a preliminary breath test with a result of 0.15 BrAC. The driver, a Deephaven resident age 61, was placed under arrest for DWI and transported to the Deephaven Police Department. The driver submitted to a breath test with a result of 0.17 BrAC. The driver was transported to Hennepin County Jail for Third Degree DWI.
	Traffic Stop - False Info- Warrant- Arrest	2026-03-29	While running stationary radar the officer observed a vehicle traveling at 50 MPH on Vine Hill Road in a posted 35 MPH zone. The officer made a traffic stop and the driver was slow to stop. The driver did not have his identification with him in the vehicle and gave his name and date of birth. The name matched with a similar individual with a warrant. The officer detained the male until he could be identified. The driver initially admitted to providing a friend's name because he did not want to get in trouble. The male was told he was under arrest for providing a false name of another person. HCSO arrived with an IBUS and Officer was able to positively identify the male. The male was transported to Hennepin County Jail.
	Tamper with Motor Vehicle	2026-03-31	Officer responded to a report of motor vehicle tampering overnight. The RP said she had left her vehicle in the driveway with the driver's door unlocked. The RP said she went to bed around midnight and got back in her car around 11 am. The RP said the contents of her center console had been removed, but no items were missing or damaged. The RP does not have any cameras on the outside of the house.
	Tamper with M/V- Theft from Auto	2026-03-31	An officer was dispatched to a theft from auto report. A vehicle had been unlocked and rummaged through overnight. A backpack had been taken and a video of the theft was obtained.

Accidents March 2026

Accident	Date	Details
PD Accident	2026-03-01	Officer was dispatched to an accident where a driver backed into a power pole in the Summerville Rd. area. The pole did not seem structurally damaged and the driver was able to drive the vehicle away.
PI Accident	2026-03-28	Officers responded to a single car crash with injuries at Vine Hill Road and Willow Haven. The driver stated he fell asleep while driving after being awake for more than 24hrs. The driver admitted to drinking earlier, but did not show sufficient signs of impairment for a DWI arrest. The driver was evaluated by EMS and self-transported to the hospital. The driver was mailed a citation for careless driving and his vehicle was towed from the scene due to significant damage.
