| PD Accident               | 2026-05-03 | Officers responded to the report of a crash with unknown injuries on Highway 7 and Vine Hill Road. The officers located a two-vehicle crash with no injuries. The driver of an SUV admitted that a dog in the vehicle had jumped on her right arm causing her to hit the rear driver's side of the second vehicle before she struck the center concrete median on Highway 7. No one was injured in the collision, and an accident exchange form was completed along with a state crash report. |
| PD Accident - Hit and Run | 2026-05-15 | Officer responded to a hit and run accident report against a parked vehicle on Linwood Circle. Officer spoke to the vehicle owner, who said she parked the vehicle around 1200, and it was struck between then and 1720. The officer photographed the damage and provided the driver with a case number. The vehicle had minor damage and was not towed. Officer could not locate any cameras in the area or other information.                                                                |

Officer gathered information and provided the drivers with a crash exchange form. One driver was issued a citation for failure to yield. Kustom Karriers was dispatched and towed both vehicles due to disabling damage.
