WEATHER ALERT BULLETIN - NORTHERN NJ - JULY 31, 2025

The Englewood Cliffs Office of Emergency Management (OEM) is actively monitoring a **severe storm system** that is expected to affect our region **from Thursday**, **July 31 through Friday**, **August 1**. According to the National Weather Service, rainfall totals of **1–3 inches** are expected across most of Northern NJ, **localized areas may experience up to 5–7 inches**, and **moderate flooding** of rivers, streams, and flood-prone locations is possible due to excessive runoff.

In response to the hazardous weather forecast, Acting Governor Tahesha L. Way has declared a State of Emergency effective 2:00 PM today under Executive Order No. 394.

FLOODING & TRAVEL ADVISORY:

While Englewood Cliffs is not in a typical floodplain, the volume of rainfall may cause localized flooding on roads, driveways, and low-lying properties. Use extreme caution when traveling during heavy rain. Never drive through standing water. The depth can be deceptive and pose serious risk to life and property. If in doubt, use an alternate route.

The Borough's **Department of Public Works (DPW)** has been authorized by Administration to remain on-site on **storm standby for a minimum of 4 hours** and will respond as needed. OEM and DPW will continue to monitor conditions and activate additional support if necessary.

POWER OUTAGE & WIRE HAZARD REPORTING:

In the event of a power outage or downed wires:

- Do NOT approach or touch any wire assume all wires are energized.
- Report outages or hazards to PSE&G:
 - Call: 1-800-436-PSEG (7734)
 - Text "OUT" to 4PSEG (47734) (register first by texting "REG")
 - Online: nj.pseg.com/outageandgasleaks
- Do NOT call the Police Department for non-emergency power-related inquiries.

SAFETY TIPS:

- Charge your devices and prepare flashlights and batteries.
- Avoid basement use or storage during active rainfall.
- Clear storm drains near your property if safe.
- Check on elderly or at-risk neighbors.
