ARTICLE I. PURPOSE AND SCOPE

The purpose of the Storage of Vehicles Policy is to regulate the storage of abandoned or unlicensed vehicles on vacant property.

ARTICLE II. DEFINITIONS

Abandoned, uninspected, unlicensed, inoperative, discarded or junked vehicles:

- A. Any vehicle that is:
 - (1) Without a current inspection sticker or license;
 - (2) Being held or used for the purpose of resale of used parts therefrom or for the purpose of reclaiming for use some of the materials;
 - (3) Wrecked, discarded or dismantled; or
 - (4) In such a condition as to cost more to repair and place in operating condition that its reasonable market value after such repair.
- B. With respect to any vehicle not required to be licensed or not usually used on the public highways, the fact that such vehicle has remained unused for more than six months and is not in condition to be removed under its own power shall be presumptive evidence that such vehicle is an abandoned, junked and/or inoperative vehicle.
- C. The fact that a vehicle does not display a current motor vehicle registration, license plate or inspection sticker shall be presumptive evidence that such vehicle is not in any condition for legal use upon city streets or highways.

ARTICLE III. STORAGE ON VACANT PROPERTY

- A. No vacant property shall be used for the storage of abandoned, uninspected, unlicensed, inoperative, discarded or junked vehicles.
- B. No vacant property shall be used for the storage of dismantled, partially dismantled or parts of vehicles.
