ARTICLE I. GENERAL PROVISIONS

A. CONTRACTS

Fillmore City contracts for waste management as follows:

- (1) Garbage pick up service is contracted
- (2) Landfill and dumpster maintenance (at the main dumpster site) is contracted with Millard County
- (3) Larger commercial businesses contract directly with Millard County for dumpster pick-up. These businesses will not be charged the landfill fee by Fillmore City on their utility bills.

B. RATES

All rates for waste management are listed in the Fillmore City Fee and Rate Schedule, Article VII – Utility Rates. (02/17/04) The City Council may adjust rates as needed. The garbage contractor may levy additional fees on commercial customers for bin services, with City Council approval. Garbage is charged whenever there is an electrical hook-up for indoor use. (02/17/04)

C. LANDFILL DEMOLITION RATE

A demolition permit must be issued by Fillmore City prior to the demolition of any structure larger than 120 square feet. A \$10 processing fee is required with the application. Landfill fees will be paid to Millard County.

D. WASTE CONTAINERS

Receptacles for waste collection must conform to city approved standards for ease of handling in size, shape and weight, and as required by the collection contractor. Containers must be removed from the street right-of-way within a reasonable time after the waste has been collected, and at least within twenty-four hours.

ARTICLE II. OPEN BURNING

(1) Open burning (by permit from the Fillmore City Fire Chief) shall be allowed of vegetation that is incident to yard clean-up activities during the periods March 30 through May 30 and September 15 through October 30 UNLESS, as determined by the Fillmore City Fire Chief that hazardous conditions exist. In which case, open burning may be completely banned upon order of the Fillmore City Fire Chief. (Amended 4-15-97)

ARTICLE III. PROHIBITED PRACTICES

A. RANDOM DUMPING

Dumping waste is prohibited except at the designated locations.

B. HAZARDOUS WASTE

Dumping of hazardous waste is prohibited.
