Wastewater Master Plan Summary Town of Fortville, Indiana

The Fortville Wastewater Master Plan has identified the following areas of need within the System:

- 1. The service area has experienced significant growth within the past few years.

 Indications are that the Town of Fortville is very desirable because of quality of life issues including schools, home values, and inexpensive utilities.
- 2. Due to the Town's projected growth, the existing utilities will need to be expanded and improved.
- 3. The interceptors are near capacity. New interceptors will be needed in order to offload and reroute flows to the plant.
- 4. Sewer main extensions will be needed to facilitate service area expansion.
- 5. Installation of gravity lines will be encouraged in order to eliminate lift stations.
- 6. Long term development may require the development of a new treatment plant.
- 7. Infiltration and inflow (I/I) has been significantly reduced in the system. Flow monitoring may be needed in order to further reduce I/I.
- 8. Numerous financing options are available to implement system wide improvements. Developers will be responsible for installing required utilities for each specific development at their expense.
