WHEREAS, by Resolution dated February 6, 2018, the Board resolved to release the performance bond required by the Resolution of the Planning Board dated July 15, 2008 to cover the full costs of the required public improvements in connection with the Map of Sea Isle Marina subject to the approval of the Council as provided in §33 of the NYS General City Law

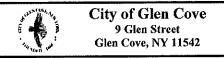
