Since taking office, my priority and dedication has been to the residents of Glen Cove. I have done my best to be responsive, respectful, transparent and inclusive. I care about improving life in Glen Cove for everyone, from the youngest to our senior citizens. As you may have noticed, my administration has been extremely busy!

In addition to the improvements at Morgan Park evident already, we are in the process of acquiring funding for continued repairs on the sea wall and the beautiful pavilions down near the beach. We have made improvements at Maccarone Stadium (bleachers, benches, sprinklers, plantings, and more) and the old basketball court has been totally rehabilitated. Take a ride down and stop in for a little dribbling practice.

At the Glen Cove Golf Course, the new Driving Range and Pro Shop are open for business. Also in Stanco Park, two additional pickleball courts have been added. Pickleball frenzy has hit Glen Cove and is here to stay.

To make a more enjoyable Summer season, the bathrooms at Prybil's Beach were renovated. Unfortunately, we are also working to install WiFi and surveillance cameras at our beaches because we have suffered incidents of vandalism at our beach bathrooms.

At Pascucci Field, lighting and sprinklers were repaired and field repairs were made. Sod is set to be installed this fall as well as a plan for brand new pickleball and futsal courts.

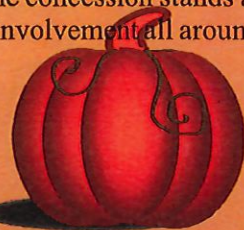
My administration was able to secure a refund from the County for the overpayment of PILOT payments. We were able to obtain \$778,000 for the City and \$805,000 for the Glen Cove School District.

Glen Cove has begun the process of creating a new Comprehensive Master Plan. This is the first time in 14 years that our City has embarked on a project such as this.

This past Summer the Senior Center was in full swing with their many programs. Also, you may have seen the Youth Bureau kids working in the Summer Youth Employment Program (SYEP) all around the city cleaning streets, working the concession stands at the stadium, painting fire hydrants and creating murals at the Senior Center and stadium. Such community involvement all around Glen Cove!

I look forward to continuing my work alongside our City Council, our CDA, our local and federal leaders and all our residents to ensure fiscal responsibility, a comprehensive growth plan and a prosperous future for the community we all love.

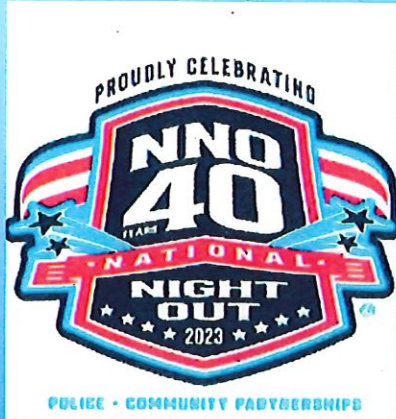

Join the City in Planning for Glen Cove's Future!

The City of Glen Cove has begun updating its Comprehensive Plan and encourages you to participate in shaping the City's future.

Glen Cove's current Master Plan was adopted in 2009, and the time for an update is now. The *2023-2024 Smart Growth Comprehensive Plan with Sustainability Elements* will analyze existing conditions; identify community resources and needs; and provide recommendations for a broad array of topics, including future land use, transportation, parking, housing, community facilities, downtown, economic development, and natural resources.

We hope you'll join the process! Start by visiting www.glencovecomprehensiveplan.com to learn more about the plan. Check out the "Contact Us" button on the website. The City needs and wants your input.

There will be many opportunities to participate in the planning process during the upcoming year. Additional meetings and a public survey are planned for the fall 2023 to spring 2024, and updates and plan chapters will be available for review at www.glencovecomprehensiveplan.com.

Glen Cove is receiving funding from the New York State Department of State Environmental Protection Fund via its Smart Growth Program for the project; the project has also been funded by the Climate Smart Communities Grant Program, Title 15 of the Environmental Protection Fund through the New York State Department of Environmental Conservation.

Community Development Nassau County Block Grant

This grant partially funded the new basketball court adjacent to John MacCarone Stadium. The now six-basket court allows either full-court playing or two half-court playing. The project included state-of-the-art acrylic breakaway backboards and height-adjustable rims; new pavement; new paint & new benches; a repaired walkway and trees trimmed back.

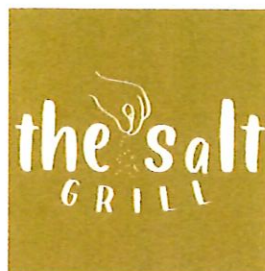

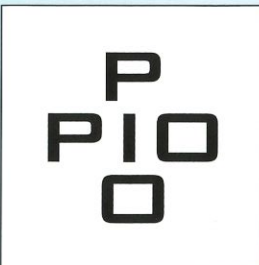

LEAF AND YARD WASTE DISPOSAL -Leaves and all yard waste must be placed in **CLEAR** plastic bags!

Wednesday is the day for leaf pick up.

Please put them out on Tuesday evening or Wednesday morning before 7:00 a.m. Leaves that are not in clear bags or are mixed with other garbage or yard waste will not be picked up. **Please help the City avoid unnecessary fees by bagging your leaves separately in clear plastic bags.**

Composting is great for growing flowers and vegetables: it returns nutrients to the soil and saves City labor and equipment costs. More information on composting is available at City Hall or on website: www.glencoveny.gov

Do not rake or blow leaves into the street! Raking or blowing leaves into the street becomes a safety hazard and is prohibited by the Glen Cove Municipal Code. Violations will be issued to both the homeowner and the landscaper if one is involved.

Commercial and Retail Property Maintenance: The owner or occupant of every commercial or retail facility in the City is responsible for keeping the sidewalks, curbs and adjoining parking areas clean and free from trash, dirt, weeds, rubbish and obstructions of any kind. Any accumulation of papers, boxes, debris, garbage, ashes, sweepings, cans or refuse should be cleaned up in a timely fashion. Failure to comply with the code may result in the issuance of court summonses.

Dog Licenses: Dogs over the age of 4 months are required to be licensed. Under the authority of New York State Department of Agriculture and Markets, the City Clerk's Office issues dog licenses.

Dog licenses are to be renewed yearly. A license will help to find your dog if it is lost.

Garage Sales: Permits are required for garage/yard sales. NO SIGNS are to be posted on public property. ANY SIGNS POSTED MUST BE REMOVED FOLLOWING GARAGE SALE.

Prior to a garage sale, you must obtain a garage sale permit (\$15.00 fee) at the Glen Cove Clerk's Office at City Hall, Third Floor, 9 Glen Street.
