STOP (Stop Throwing Out Pollutants):

April 11th 2026 & September 12th 2026

8am - 2pm at Winters Bros. Waste System, Morris Avenue

Bring items such as aerosol cans, air conditioning refrigerants, antifreeze, brake and transmission fluids, bug and rodent killers, paint thinner, oven cleaner, polish and wood preservatives, unused flammable liquids, waste oil, insecticides, pesticides, fertilizers, rug and upholstery cleaners, pool chemicals and barbecue propane tanks (all with contents), Fluorescent Bulbs (only) and Helium Tanks (empty or full). ***Proof of residency required.*** Residential waste only. No explosives, smoke detectors, fireworks, medical waste. Starting May 1st you can also bring enamel, lead, oil-based, latex, and water-based paint to the next scheduled STOP Program.

Bring the following for proper disposal: Computer monitors, computers, laptops, desktops, tablets & e-readers, hard drives, printers (less than 100lbs.) document scanners, keyboards, mice & cables, copiers, fax machines, VCRs, DVRs, portable digital music players, DVD players, converter boxes, cable/satellite receivers, stereos, televisions & electronic games for proper disposal. Do Not bring microwaves and small household appliances.
