Glen Cove City Employees Open Their Hearts to Rescued Cats Following Large-Scale Animal Rescue

GLEN COVE, NY — Following a recent large-scale animal rescue in Glen Cove involving an overwhelming number of cats and kittens removed from unsafe living conditions, several City of Glen Cove employees stepped up by opening their homes and hearts to some of the rescued animals.

What began as a heartbreaking situation is now becoming a story of compassion, generosity, and second chances. City employees not only adopted several of the cats and kittens, but also donated food, supplies, and their time to support the care and recovery of the remaining animals.

“It was impossible not to want to help,” said Sue Tripp, one of the first city employees to step up and adopt. “These kittens have been through so much, and I’m grateful to be able to give one a loving home.”

The rescue effort brought together city officials, animal rescue organizations, veterinarians, law enforcement, and volunteers, all working to help the cats heal, adjust, and find safe, loving homes.

Mayor Pamela Panzenbeck thanked everyone who played a role in the rescue and recovery effort.

“The compassion shown throughout this rescue effort has been truly remarkable,” said Mayor Panzenbeck. “From the volunteers and rescue groups to our own city employees who stepped up to adopt and donate, this has been a powerful reminder of the kindness and heart within our Glen Cove community.”
