THE GLEN COVE ADULT DAY PROGRAM

The Glen Cove Adult Day Program is excited to see signs of early Fall in September! We had a memorable summer season in ADP, and we look forward to the transition of the weather, leaves changing color, and pumpkin spice everything! September was originally the seventh month of the year, which is why its name comes from the Latin word *septem*, meaning "seven." In September, we wish our Virgo and Libra friends happy birthdays! September is often associated with new beginnings, as the school year starts for children, and seasonal weather changes bring about a sense of renewal. Most notably, we celebrate Labor Day in September, and we will also recognize Grandparents Day, Constitution Day, International Day of Peace, Rosh Hashanah, the Autumnal Equinox, and Johnny Appleseed Day. ADP will be engaging in various activities that incorporate themes like Autumn, cider, leaves, back to school, occupations, blueberries, and indoor gardening.

ADP collaborates with many local organizations, agencies, and colleges to enhance our programming. We continue to have Music Therapy regularly through the National Enrichment Group. Our weekly American Sign Language class is an educational opportunity brought to us by our friends at the Mill Neck Manor School for the Deaf. We have a great time doing gardening projects and learning about different plants, herbs, and flowers during our Horticulture Therapy program, which is brought to us this month by Lori Sherman. ADP hosts artistic virtual programming that is brought to us through the Long Island Museum in Stony Brook, which is titled "In the Moment." This art-viewing and art-making program allows us to create our own work after exploring the museum's exhibits. We are excited to continue our new monthly activity, called "Sip & Socialize," brought to us by Pam Kiperman from Sunrise of Glen Cove and Judith Rivera from CareFirst Home Solutions! We regularly work on maintaining our physicality with Zumba, Tai Chi, Mind & Body Movement, Strength Training, modified Aerobics classes, and our Balance, Strength, & Fitness classes. Our friend Anna from the Arbors will join us this month to host a special craft activity. ADP will be taking a trip this month to the Nassau County Museum of Art in Roslyn for a "Meet Me in the Galleries" program. Our friend Steve Fratello, who is a naturalist, lepidopterist, and explorer, and who has spent nearly 1,000 days exploring rainforests, will present his rare collection of butterflies and moths this month. In addition, our friends from the Alley Pond Environmental Center will be bringing several live critters for us to see and learn about in a presentation called "Animals Alive!" The Glen Cove Adult Day Program offers a variety of programming to create a stimulating and entertaining environment for older adults.


