Testing Results to Date at Permanent Monitoring Wells

Various concentrations of Per-and Polyfluoroalkyl Substances (PFAS) "Forever Chemicals" were detected in the monitoring wells sampled during the July & October 2024 sampling events. The following PFAS compounds were detected at a concentration that exceeds an established regulatory criterion: Perfluorooctanoic Acid (PFOA) was detected in each of the 4 monitoring wells at concentrations exceeding the regulatory criteria of 0.0079 ng/L.
