ORDINANCE #022

AN ORDINANCE OFTHE CITY OF HIGHLAND HAVEN, TEXAS, CERTIFING THAT THE THREE QUALIFIED CITIZENS WHO FILED FOR A POSITION ON THE 1997 ELECTION ABALLOT WERE UNOPPOSED AND THEY ARE ELECTED TO THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN.

WHEREAS, three positions on the Board of Aldermen were to b filed during the May 1997 election; and

WHEREAS, three qualified citizens filed for a position on the ballot for the May 1997 election; and

WHEREAS, the election official for the City of Highland Haven, Texas has furnished written certification of the unopposed status of the three qualified citizens that filed for a position on the May 1997 election ballot, and

WHEREAS, the Texas Election Code Section §2.053 (a), authorizes the Board of Aldermen of the City of Highland Haven, Texas to declare each unopposed candidate elected to office when the number of qualified citizens filing for a position on the ballot equals the number of vacancies to be filled.

NOW THEREFORE:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF HIGHLAND HAVEN, TEXAS.

That the three qualified citizens, Jean Everett, Lois Kalisvaart, and Joe Ormiston are elected to the Board of Aldermen of the City of Highland Haven, Texas effective May 3, 1997.
