ORDINANCE # 064

AN ORDINANCE OFTHE CITY OF HIGHLAND HAVEN, TEXAS, CERTIFYING THAT THE THREE QUALIFIED CITIZENS WHO FILED FOR THE VACANT POSITIONS ON THE 2008 ELECTION BALLOT WERE UNOPPOSED AND ARE THEREFORE ELECTED AS ALDERMEN AND MAYOR.

WHEREAS, two positions on the Board of Aldermen and the position of Mayor were to be filled during the May 2008 election; and

WHEREAS, three qualified citizens filed for these positions on the ballot for the May 2008 election; and

WHEREAS, the election official for the City of Highland Haven, Texas has furnished written certification of the unopposed status of the three qualified citizens that filed for a position on the May 2008 election ballot, and

WHEREAS, the Texas Election Code Section §2.053 (a) authorizes the Board of Aldermen of the City of Highland Haven, Texas to declare each unopposed candidate elected to office when the number of qualified citizens filing for a position on the ballot equals the number of vacancies to be filled.

NOW THEREFORE:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF HIGHLAND HAVEN, TEXAS.

That the three qualified citizens Aldermen George Burris and Angelo Anzivino are elected Aldermen and that Peter Freehill is elected Mayor in the City of Highland Haven, Texas effective May 15, 2008.
