Whereas, Don Adams is qualified to serve as judge of the Municipal Court and has agreed to serve in such capacity as a community service on an "as needed" basis, and

Whereas, Judge Adams has served as Highland Haven Municipal Judge since 2008, and

Whereas, such an arrangement would result in obtaining a qualified judge for the Municipal Court without causing a significant financial burden on the City of Highland Haven, now therefore, be it

RESOLVED, the Board of Aldermen of the City of Highland Haven, Texas does hereby reappoint Don Adams as Judge of the Municipal Court of the City of Highland Haven, Texas effective as of February 16, 2013 to serve for a period of four (4) years.
