AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF HIGHLAND HAVEN, TEXAS, CERTIFYING THAT TWO QUALIFIED CITIZENS WHO FILED FOR THE VACANT POSITIONS ON THE 2019 ELECTION BALLOT WERE UNOPPOSED AND ARE THEREFORE ELECTED.

Whereas, two positions on the Board of Aldermen were to be filled during the May 4, 2019 election; and

Whereas, two qualified citizens filed for two of these positions on the ballot for the May 4, 2019 election; and

Whereas, the election official for the City of Highland Haven, Texas has furnished written certification of the unopposed status of the two qualified citizens that filed for a position of Alderperson on the May 2019 election ballot.

Whereas, the Texas Election Code Section §2.053 (a) authorizes the Board of Aldermen of the City of Highland Haven, Texas to declare each unopposed candidate elected to office when the number of qualified citizens filing for a position on the ballot equals or is less than the number of vacancies to be filled.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF HIGHLAND HAVEN, TEXAS THAT:

The two qualified citizens, Lonnie Ball and Lorinda Peters are elected to the positions of Alderperson for two years, in the City of Highland Haven, Texas, effective May 4, 2019.

PASSED AND APPROVED this the 21 day of May, 2019, by a yes vote of 4 and a no vote of 0.
