Today's the Last Day for Early Voting

Polls are open until 7 p.m. tonight at both Burnet County Locations

Dear Highland Haven Residents,

I hope you're enjoying this crisp Halloween as we wrap up another busy month in our community. It's hard to believe we're already at the final stretch of early voting for the November 4 bond election!

Today, **Friday, October 31**, is the **last day to vote early—and polls are open until 7 p.m.** at either Burnet County location:

- Texas Tech University at Highland Lakes (806 Steve Hawkins Pkwy., Marble Falls, TX 78654)
- AgriLife Extension Auditorium (607 N. Vandeveer St., Burnet, TX 78611)

If you miss today, you'll need to wait until Election Day on Tuesday, November 4 (7 a.m. to 7 p.m.) to cast your ballot.

Quick facts on Proposition A (the \$1,000,000 General Obligation Bond):

- Funds the purchase of adjacent property to the water plant and infrastructure updates.
- No increase to water rates—our rates already cover all fixed costs, and the new bond's annual payments are ~\$13,000 less than our current bond (which it will replace once paid off in 2027).
- No debt service (I&S) tax—while the ballot notes "This is a Tax Increase" (a state required statement for GO bonds), the City will repay it from water system revenues (our enterprise fund), just as we do now. Any brief overlap will be covered by reserves.
