ORDINANCE NO. 72

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF JACKSON, COUNTY OF CAMBRIA, COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA, PROHIBITING THE PARKING, STOPPING, AND/OR STANDING OF MOTOR VEHICLES AT ALL TIMES ALONG ROUTE 271 FIVE HUNDRED (500) FEET IN EITHER DIRECTION ALONG THE EASTERLY SIDE OF ROUTE 271 FROM THE INTERSECTION OF BRACKEN STREET AND ROUTE 271.

ARTICLE I

STATEMENT OF PURPOSE

WHEREAS, the Supervisors of the Township of Jackson, for the purpose of providing a safe and reasonable viewing distance of oncoming traffic, improved traffic flow, and providing for the public safety and welfare; and

WHEREAS, the Supervisors of the Township of Jackson have reviewed engineering and traffic studies performed by William Battista, Township of Jackson Engineer, which deem it necessary to provide for the regulation of parking, stopping and standing of motor vehicles along Route 271 five hundred (500) feet in either direction along the easterly side of Route 271 from the intersection of the center line of Bracken Street with Route 271; and

WHEREAS, the Supervisors feel in view of this information that the ordinance enacting regulation of parking is appropriate.

## ARTICLE II DEFINITIONS

1. "Park" or "Parking". The halting of a motor vehicle, whether occupied or not, except momentarily for the purpose of and while actually engaged in loading or unloading of passengers.

2. "Stop" or "Stopping". The halting of a motor vehicle, whether occupied or not, except momentarily for the purpose of and while actually engaged in receiving or discharging passengers.

3. "Stand" or "Standing". Any halting, even momentarily, of a motor vehicle, whether occupied or not, except when necessary to avoid conflict with other traffic or in compliance with the directions of a police officer or traffic-control sign or signal.

## ARTICLE III REGULATION OF PARKING

1. The parking, stopping and/or standing of a motor vehicle or motor vehicles is and shall be prohibited at all times five hundred (500) feet in either direction along the easterly side of Route 271 from the intersection of Bracken Street with 271.

2. The Township of Jackson's roadmaster, his employees and/or agents, shall erect signs five hundred (500) feet in either direction along the easterly side of Route 271 from the intersection of Bracken with Route 271 which shall state that "parking, stopping, and/or standing is prohibited at all times" and said signs shall be in accord with Title 67 of the Pennsylvania Code, Sections 211.231 through and including Sections 211.240 in all respects, including, but not limited to size, color, mounting and intervals.

#### **ARTICLE VI PENALTIES**

1. Any person or persons violating this Ordinance shall be guilty of a summary offense, and upon conviction thereof before any district magistrate, or any justice of the peace, having jurisdiction thereof, shall be sentenced to pay a fine of not more than Fifteen and 00/100 (\$15.00) Dollars plus costs of prosecution.

#### **ARTICLE V MISCELLANEOUS**

1. In the event that any part or parts of this Ordinance shall be declared illegal or void, the remaining part or parts hereof shall remain in full force and effect.

2. All ordinances or parts thereof heretofore enacted that are inconsistent with this Ordinance are hereby repealed.
