ORDINANCE NO. 98

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 96

Ordinance No. 96 is hereby amended as follows:


Section 1. Improved Property -- The words "or animals" are hereby deleted. The remainder of this section remains in full force and effect.

Section 2-D. The second paragraph should read in its entirety as follows:

"Each such privy, privy vault, cesspool, sinkhole, septic tank or similar receptacle shall be abandoned upon the making of a required connection to the Sewer Systems and may be emptied and filled, but this is not required, as septic tanks need only be blocked at both ends, subject to the satisfaction of the Township or Authority; and any such privy, privy vault, cesspool, sinkhole, septic tank or similar receptacle not so properly abandoned, shall constitute a nuisance and such nuisance shall be abated as provided by law."
