**OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE TOWNSHIP OF
JACKSON SUPPORTING THE JACKSON ELEMENTARY
SCHOOL'S CONTINUED OPERATION AND OPPOSING ANY
ATTEMPT TO CLOSE THE JACKSON ELEMENTARY SCHOOL.**

WHEREAS, the Central Cambria School District - Jackson Elementary School must be adequately funded and supported in order to prevent prolonged learning disruptions which threaten our future and the well-being of our children, the Central Cambria School District communities, and the local economy; and

WHEREAS, the best interests of our students cannot be compromised because of financial errors made by School Administrators,

WHEREAS, the Jackson Elementary School provides an ongoing positive benefit to the Central Cambria School District and the Township of Jackson.

WHEREAS, our children's future well-being relies on providing our youngest citizens access to high quality education and program support by keeping open the Jackson Elementary School.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Jackson Township Supervisors call upon the Central Cambria School Board to (1) immediately end any plans to close the Central Cambria School District - Jackson Elementary School, to (2) support quality education to ensure that our students, our taxpayers, and our school district are not penalized for errors made by School Administrators, and to (3) support the Jackson Elementary School's continued operation and ongoing benefit to the students, taxpayers, and the Central Cambria School District.
