- ☐ Complete the Operator's License Application (reverse side)
- ☐ Pay the License Fee of \$20.00 and \$15.00 if a Temporary License is also needed (due at time of application and is nonrefundable if application is denied.)
- ☐ A background check will be conducted by the Town of Lafayette
- ☐ Provide proof of successfully completing a training course that is approved by the Wisconsin Department of Revenue (must be completed within the last two years) or proof that you have been a licensed bartender in the State of Wisconsin within the last two years.
- ☐ Classes are provided at the Chippewa Valley Technical College or you can find courses online. Select a training course under the title "Alcohol Seller/Server".
- ☐ Renewal applications should be submitted 30-60 days prior to the expiration date to allow for processing time and Town Board approval

Applicant's Statement

I, the undersigned, do hereby respectfully make application to the Town Board of the Town of Lafayette, Chippewa County, Wisconsin for a license to serve, from the date hereof to June 30, 20__, inclusive (unless sooner revoked) Fermented Malt Beverages and Intoxicating Liquors, subject to the limitations imposed by Section 125.32(2) and 125.68(2) of the Wisconsin Statutes and all acts amendatory thereof and supplementary thereto, and hereby agree to comply with all laws, resolutions, ordinances and regulations, Federal, State or Local affecting the sale of such beverages and liquors. I hereby testify that the above information is true and accurate

I further understand that the Town performs background checks on all applicants and that the Town of Lafayette may suspend, revoke or deny a license issued upon this application if the applicant fails to provide requested information or is not truthful in completion of this application. The Town of Lafayette does not issue licenses or permits related to alcohol beverages to any person who has habitually been a law offender or has been convicted of a felony that the Town determines, substantially relates to the licensing activity unless the person has been duly pardoned. Even if the license has been granted by the Town Board, it will be held if you owe any outstanding fines, forfeitures or other debts to the Town. Because application fees offset the cost to process your application, the fees are non-refundable regardless of whether you obtain a license or not.
