

LeRay Township Annual Reconvene Meeting Minutes
August 12, 2025

The LeRay Township Annual Meeting was reconvened at 6:30 pm. Present were Kurt Anderson, Phyllis Daschner, Bev Peters and Ann Arndt, Craig & Jordan were absent.

Deputy Clerk Arndt provided a recap of the Annual Meeting. It was recommended at the Annual meeting the Levy would be 6%.

Treasurer Peters provided the Board with a recap of financials to date. She said the disbursements were down this year. The board would like to move forward with Levy at 6%.

With the increased costs of everything in this economy and considering the future needs of the township a motion was made by Kurts to increase the levy by 6%, seconded by Phyllis, all in favor, motion passed. The township will have a 6% increase levy for 2026.

We reviewed the current fire contracts. St. Clair is getting a new truck, Janesville is proposing a new truck and we are requesting Madison Lake review the method they are using to calculate the township expense allocation.

Discussion held on condition of roads: brush was trimmed. We are having trouble with 628th, it is not being used as a minimum maintenance road, Nick thinks we should take up the rock in a 100 foot patch to calculate a cost and deter use. He has been doing minor culvert work. Need to work on cottonwood trees by Bray Park.

Total amount of funds we will receive in 2026 will be \$489,377.20. Motioned by Kurt, seconded by Phyllis to increase Levy to 6%. All in favor; motion carried.
