General Election Day is November 4th. Mail-in ballots will be sent out by Cache County beginning October 14th. Due to changes in the Utah Code, I highly recommend not mailing your completed ballot back to the county, but rather deposit it in any official ballot dropbox. In Lewiston, we have one at the corner of the theatre building, just south of the entrance doors. These boxes are emptied regularly by county election workers. The new code says that ballots must be received by election officials by 8:00pm on election day to be counted—it no longer matters what the postmark says. Inconsistencies within the postal system cannot guarantee your ballot will be delivered on time. Election information can be found on our website at lewistonutah.gov/elections. Thank you.
