- Priority given to students who qualify for free or reduced lunch and meet certain risk factors (financial assistance available to families who qualify)

Public Works Laborer—Full-Time/Hourly Pay/Benefited—\$19-\$24/hr DOQ

Job Summary: The Public Works Laborer performs a variety of manual labor and maintenance tasks in support of the city's public infrastructure and facilities. This position is responsible for assisting in the construction, repair, and upkeep of streets, sidewalks, parks, water and sewer systems, public buildings, and the cemetery. Work is performed under supervision and may involve operating light to heavy equipment, using hand and power tools, and working in varying weather conditions. The role may also support emergency response efforts, including fire and medical assistance, when certified.
