FIRE RESTRICTION ORDER NO. 2026-01

Issued Pursuant to Lewiston City Code § 4-1-6(G), the Governor's Emergency Declaration, the Utah State Forester's Stage 2 Fire Restriction Order, and applicable Utah law.

Effective: 12:01 a.m. on June 27, 2026

Pursuant to Lewiston City Code § 4-1-6(G), the Governor's Emergency Declaration, the Utah State Forester's Stage 2 Fire Restriction Order, and applicable Utah law, the Lewiston City Fire Chief hereby issues the following emergency fire restrictions and establishes the following municipally designated fireworks area within Lewiston City.

Stage 2 Fire Restrictions

The Utah State Forester's Stage 2 Fire Restrictions for Cache County shall apply within Lewiston City in the following areas:

- All property located east of 800 East, except properties fronting Sugar Lane as identified in the Municipally Designated Fireworks Area below;
- All property located west of 2400 West; and
- Any location within Lewiston City where dry or cured vegetation capable of carrying fire exists within one hundred (100) yards of the point of ignition.

All prohibitions, exceptions, and enforcement provisions contained in the Utah State Forester's Stage 2 Fire Restriction Order are incorporated into this Order unless specifically modified herein.

Municipally Designated Fireworks Area

Pursuant to the Governor's Emergency Declaration, Lewiston City designates the following area for the discharge of consumer fireworks:

- All property located between 800 East and 2400 West; and
- Properties fronting Sugar Lane immediately east of 800 East.

Consumer fireworks may be discharged only during the dates and hours authorized by Utah law.

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Consumer fireworks are prohibited:

- Within one hundred (100) yards of any dry or cured vegetation capable of carrying fire;
- In violation of any applicable federal, state, or local law;
- On property without the permission of the property owner; or
- Outside the municipally designated fireworks area described above.

Nothing in this Order authorizes the use of fireworks prohibited under Utah law.

Enforcement

This Order may be enforced by the Lewiston City Fire Department, the Cache County Sheriff's Office, or any other peace officer authorized by law.

Violations may be prosecuted pursuant to applicable provisions of Utah law and Lewiston City ordinances.

Severability

If any provision of this Order is determined to be invalid or unenforceable, the remaining provisions shall remain in full force and effect.

Effective Period

This Order becomes effective at 12:01 a.m. on June 27, 2026, and shall remain in effect until rescinded by the Lewiston City Fire Chief or until the Utah State Forester rescinds the applicable Stage 2 Fire Restriction Order, whichever occurs first.
