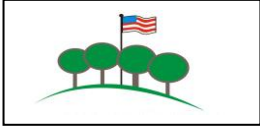

## From our Town Chairman:

With visitors now arriving and the ideas of yard sales and special one day events, I will remind everyone that serving alcohol requires a permit from the town. If you are hosting a private party by invitation only guests, you are allowed to have alcohol but a publicly advertised event requires a permit through the Town office. The reason for that is accountability should anything happen legally with someone who has left that premises. Please contact the office for information on acquiring a one-day liquor license.

In the near future there will be roads that will have a coating called chip seal on them. This is a thin layer of liquid tar and an application of gravel placed on top. This process lengthens the life of an asphalt road by a good 7 or 8 years and at about \$140,000.00 per mile for asphalt we try to lengthen the life as much as we can. While driving on a road that has been chip sealed, drive slowly so that the chips aren't thrown to the bottom of your vehicle. The more the road is driven on, the chips will stay down on the road and soon become part of the solid surface.

And finally, this time of year dogs love to be outdoors. Please remember that in Liberty Grove you are to have your dog licensed. Per Ordinance 2-82, "Section 1. Dogs Not to Run At Large. It shall be unlawful for any person owning, keeping or harboring any dog, to permit such dog to run at large within the limits of the Town of Liberty Grove, Door County, Wisconsin, at any time. A dog is considered to be running at large if it is off the premises of its owner and not under the control of the owner or some other person." When off the owner's premises, a dog should be leashed at all times.

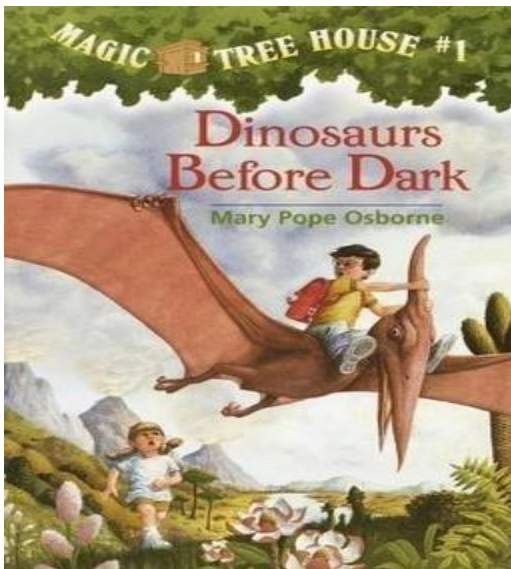

### Lake Michigan Lake Levels

The forecasted lake levels for June 28<sup>th</sup> in Lakes Superior and Michigan-Huron are above where they were last month by 4 and 3 inches, respectively. Lake St. Clair has stayed the near same level as last month, but Lakes Erie and Ontario are lower than last month by 1 inch. Compared to a year ago, Lakes Michigan-Huron and Erie are sitting near the same level, while Lake Superior is 7 inches lower, Lake St. Clair is 1 inch lower, and Lake Ontario is 11 inches lower than this time last year. Even though lake levels are down from last year, most of them are sitting above their long-term average levels, except for Lake Ontario, which is 5 inches below its June average level. All lakes are still well above their lowest recorded June average levels. Looking into next month, Lakes St. Clair, Erie, and Ontario are expected to fall by 1, 3, and 1 inch, respectively. Lake Superior is expected to rise 1 inch, and Lake Michigan-Huron is expected to stay near the same level. For more information, please see our Daily Levels web page.

### Outdoor Fires

Having an outdoor fire in the evening is always a fun family event. A portable firepit with a mesh enclosure to capture hot embers is obviously the safest to use.

If you have an open firepit please remember that your fires should be no larger than a fire that you would cook over and should never be left unattended. Grass fires can start easily and get out of hand very quickly. Have a hose or a fire extinguisher nearby for safety.
